

1. RULES

- 1.1 If provincial COVID-19 regulations permit organized sporting events, sailing will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (World Sailing), the prescriptions of the CYA, the rules of each class concerned and by these sailing instructions.
- 1.2 If provincial COVID-19 regulations do not permit organized sporting events, sailing will be governed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea 1972 (COLREGs) and by these sailing instructions.

2. ENTRIES

2.1 In order to participate in the FPSC FIASCO regatta, you must have registered by the registration cut-off date. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in being scored DNC (Did Not Compete) in any event sailed when these conditions are not met.

3. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 3.1 All notices to competitors will be posted online www.fiftypointsailingclub.com prior to 0800 on July 3, 2021.
- 3.2 Communication during racing will use **VHF channel 72**. This will be monitored by the organizers during the race.

4. CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Any changes in the sailing instructions shall be made via email to the competitors with links to the SI's online.

5. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE OR ON THE WATER

- 5.1 Signals will not be made ashore.
- 5.2 Communication with participants prior to 0800 on Saturday July 3, 2021, will be done via email with links to the Notice Board at www.fiftypointsailingclub.com.
- 5.3 Communication on water will occur via VHF channel 72.

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1 Sailing will commence at 10:00 am EDT on Saturday, July 3, 2021 with the first boat.
- 6.2 Boats will start at their assigned time, as determined from their PHRF handicap. Starting times are assigned based on Time on Distance and are provided in **Appendix B Start Times**.
- 6.3 The curfew for racers to be finished is **18:00 EDT on July 3**, **2021**. Boats finishing after this time will be scored DNF.

7. THE COURSE

- 7.1 Refer to the mark locations (**Appendix A**) and course descriptions of these instructions for the course layout and the approximate distance between marks.
- 7.2 The course will be communicated to participants prior to the start via email.

8. MARKS

- 8.1 Turning marks are designated as per **Appendix A** and are of various shape and size with approximate GPS locations.
- 8.2 The course consists of 3 marks (NFS and FS Fleets) inclusive of the start/finish. These marks coincide with the Start/Finish lines at each point.
- 8.3 All marks are rounding marks.
- 8.4 Mark roundings can be done either to port or starboard, however they must be done so that *the boat must pass outside the triangle inscribed by the race marks* denoted in Appendix A.
- 8.5 Following the start, marks can be rounded in any order, subject to instruction 8.4, above.

9. THE START

- 9.1 Times listed are calculated based on PHRF handicap and Time on Distance.
- 9.2 The start line will be between the two marks positioned at each turning location (see Figure 1). The starting area is defined as the area surrounding the start line that extends three (3) boat lengths beyond the port and starboard ends of the line as well as three (3) boat lengths above and below the start line. All yachts not starting within 1 minute should remain outside of this area.
- 9.3 Participants are responsible for ensuring that they do not start early. If a boat is deemed to have started early, it must return to the start line in order to restart. Such determination will be made on the HONOUR SYSTEM.
- 9.4 Participants will be provided with a Starting time following registration cutoff on June 30, 2021.

10. EXCLUSION ZONE

- 10.1 An exclusion zone encompasses the Grimsby Small Arms Firing Range.
- 10.2 The exclusion zone is bounded by markers WT and WY, located approximately 1.5 nm from shore, at 43.2457N, 79.6024W and 43.2414N, 79.5915W and the shoreline and is marked with yellow markers approximately 0.1 nm apart.

10.3 Boats entering this exclusionary zone, will be scored DSQ without a protest hearing.

11. RECALLS and RETIREMENTS

11.1 Boats retiring during the race are required to inform the FIASCO organizers on VHF Channel 72 as soon as possible after retiring.

12. CHANGE OF COURSE AFTER THE START

12.1 The course will not be shortened or lengthened.

13. THE FINISH

- 13.1 The finish line will be between the inflatable marks designating the respective Start/Finish line.
- 13.2 <u>Each boat shall record its own finish time, as well as the name of the boat finishing directly ahead and the boat finishing immediately behind.</u>
- 13.3 Finish Times are to be sent to organizers as soon as possible after finishing and must be received by 19:00h on July 3.



14. TIME LIMITS

- 14.1 The curfew for racers to be finished is 18:00 EDT on July 3, 2021.
- 14.2 Boats finishing after the curfew time will be scored DNF.

15. PROTESTS

- 15.1 Protests are strongly discouraged.
- 15.2 All protests should be presented to the regatta organizers who, in turn, will take them to the protest committee.
- 15.3 The jury will hear protests on the same day/evening they are received and will rule on the outcome within 90 minutes of the final hearings.

15.4 In the event of protest, each boat must make available a GPS track depicting the boats track through the course. Failure to provide a verifiable track may result in DSQ.

16. SCORING

- 16.1 Yacht finish times will be handicapped using the PHRF LO time-on-distance scoring system.
- 16.2 In the event of contesting results, each boat must make available a GPS track depicting the boats track through the race course. Failure to provide a verifiable track may result in DSQ.

17. FLEETS

- 17.1 Fleets and Fleet Splits will be made available prior to the start.
- 17.2 Each skipper will declare his/her yacht as 'flying sails' or 'non-flying sails' at least one (3) days prior to the race. He/she will maintain that designation until the Regatta is complete.
- 17.3 Boats without PHRF certificates will automatically be placed in the "NFS Cruising Fleet" and not eligible for the Overall award.

18. MEASUREMENTS AND HANDICAP RATING

- 18.1 Any yacht with unmeasured sails, which could affect its PHRF LO rating shall have its sails measured.
- 18.2 The race committee reserves the right to inspect any member's yacht to verify its rating and compliance with club rules.
- 18.3 Measurement and handicap rating will be as per the current PHRF-LO handicapper's manual and by-laws.
- 18.4 Handicap grievances will be resolved in accordance with PHRF-LO by-laws.
- 18.5 Boats without a valid PHRF certificate will have a PHRF handicap rating provided based on PHRF-LO or PHRF-NE ratings, as available.

19. PRIZES

- 19.1 Awards will be given to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place boat in each fleet.
- 19.2 The Overall Fiasco Award will be given to the boat that finishes across the finish line first, in accordance with these Sailing Instructions.

20. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 20.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk.
- 20.2 By participating in this Regatta, all participants are aware of the inherent risks of sailing and agree to not hold the organizing authority liable for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 20.3 All Skippers are expected to make their participating crew aware of this Disclaimer of Liability and all participating crew agrees to abide by the above statement.

20.4 It is the Skippers responsibility to ensure that they are in compliance with current COVID-19 provincial regulations.

21. INSURANCE

21.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$1M per incident or equivalent.
